Installation

Device Configuration Packages are stand-alone products that do NOT require the installation of any other development tools. This DCP has been tested on Windows XP.

Device Configuration Packages support side-by-side installation. Each new version can be installed without uninstalling older versions. This allows the developer to work with several different versions on the same development PC.

The installed DCP components can be easily accessed using the "Motorola Device Configuration Packages" program group on the Windows Start Menu.

Notes

1. **Slow TCM builds** - Some versions of anti-virus software may cause the build script process of TCM to run slowly. To prevent this situation, disable the anti-virus software during builds.
